We, the members of JEF Catalunya's Board have decided, during our last meeting, to resign as members of the Board itself.

Our decision is intended to be a form of protest against the continuous and growing centralism and the progressive bureaucratization of JEF (Jeune Européens FEDERALISTES) Europe based on the systematic by-pass of our local representatives.

In particular, as former representatives of the board and current members of the JEF Catalunya itself, we want to know who has assumed the POLITICAL responsibility of the following decisions:

1. Organization in Barcelona of the November seminar "Europe's Youth in Dialogue - Cultural Diversity in the Society of Tomorrow", since the decision has been assumed without directly involving our section;
2. Taking the decision to organise one of Europe@myDesk's seminars in Spain (supposedly in San Sebastian), without - again - previously contacting our local representative;
3. Pressures in order to create the Spanish section of JEF, merging the local groups of Barcelona and Madrid, contrasting the federal and self-determination principles ruling JEF.
